You are invited to celebrate the comfort and joy of the festive season with the Craft Council Gallery's annual juried exhibit. This exhibit will include functional, non-functional, 2D and 3D works in a variety of mediums. The theme allows for works that reflect seasonal and thematic threads. Think whimsical or serious, contemporary or traditional. Innovation and craftsmanship will be considered when selecting works.

Large, fragile entries or entries that need to be shipped will be juried by digital images on CD which must be received, with a copy of the entry form by **October 29** (earlier if possible).

Other entries will be juried by actual work after **Deadline for Entries – drop off works by November 19, 2009**

ELIGIBILITY

- Each artist can submit up to three works
- All works must be for sale
- works should have been completed after December 31, 2007
- works must be original
- All entries MUST BE READY TO INSTALL. All works should come with specific installation, hanging and/or other necessary instructions in writing.
- The attached entry form should be filled out and enclosed with your entries. If you are sending more than one entry, each should be clearly marked as 1, 2 or 3
- The work must be properly packed in a reusable container suitable for gift-giving
- There is a \$20 entry fee for non-members of the Craft Council of Newfoundland and Labrador

CRITERIA

Exhibition works will be juried. All entries may not be accepted.

Works will be accepted on the basis of excellence in technique, use of materials and design. The committee will choose pieces, which will build a cohesive exhibition of one-of-a-kind works responding to the theme. While the Gallery makes every effort to include a broad range of visual art, the Gallery's priority is craft and craft based art.

HOW TO ENTER

Please notify us of your “**intent to enter**” by **October 29, 2009** by EMAILING, your name, address and brief description of what you intend to enter .

Submitting work for JURY

1. If your work is large, fragile or needs to be shipped – you can have your work juried digitally – see **guidelines below** . CDs with **digital images** (full & details) should **arrive by OCTOBER 29** and if **chosen** work should arrive by **NOVEMBER 19**.
2. All other work should be **dropped off at the Craft Council Gallery by NOVEMBER 19** to be juried.

Guidelines for Submitting Digital Images

(This is only for works that are large, fragile or need shipping – all other entries will be juried by the actual work).

Please note, when submitting digital images to the Craft Council jury it is important to attach a detailed description of your digital images with your application form. The description should include title, size, and date created, materials and techniques plus any other information you feel would be useful to the jury or committee.

1. Please ensure that each CD-ROM or DVD is clearly marked with your name and the date.
2. All files must be PC compatible.
3. All files must be jpeg files with resolution of 266 dpi.
4. Files must be a maximum of 2 MB.
5. Each file must be labeled with a number and title that corresponds with the information on the detail description of you digital images.

PLEASE NOTE this special condition relating to works chosen for an exhibition based on submitted digital images. When the work arrives it will be assessed to ensure that it meets the expectations set by the images and that there are no concerns with regard to technical or design quality that were not evident in the image. The Craft Council Gallery reserves the right to exclude work that does not accurately reflect the images submitted.

ARTISAN INFORMATION

Please EMAIL biographical information, an artist statement relating to your work, and a photo prior to the deadline or include this information on a CD.

SALES

You are required to set the **retail price** of your work (the price it will sell for). If your work is sold through the Gallery, a commission will be deducted from the retail price according to the following scale –

Retail price -	commission % we take
\$1 - \$499	33 1/3%
\$500 - \$2,499	30%
\$2500 and over	25%

SHIPPING

Each artist is responsible for the cost of packaging, shipping to gallery and return shipping for their work and insurance while in transit. Whenever possible, if not sold, works should be picked up immediately following the show. The Gallery is responsible for shipping works to buyers.

INSURANCE

The Craft Council Gallery carries limited insurance on all works while on exhibition.
