Bunty's Umbrellas will showcase needlework of all types; hand/machine embroidery, quilting, surface manipulation, fabric painted work will also be considered. It will include artists who knew and were directly influenced by Bunty and those who exhibit passion and commitment to excellence in needlework. It is open to both traditional and contemporary artists.

Bunty's Umbrellas will be exhibited in St. John's and on the Bonavista Peninsula during the Summer of 2017. Locations TBA.

All work must be for sale. Artists will receive 50% of the sale price. Final selection of participants will be made by a jury.

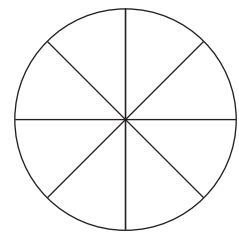


Information for Submitting an Expression of Interest

A white fabric umbrella top (blank) will be supplied. The blank is made with 50/50 cotton polyester in canvas-like plain weave. The diameter of the blank is 42" and the circle is sewn together with 8 triangular shapes of approximately 13" x 21" x 21".

Expression of Interest must include

- your name and contact information
- a brief outline of what you intend to do with description and sketches
- colour studies etc
- a CV and Artist Statement
- Photos of your current and/or related work (or links to photos) should be included if possible
